The museum is free to look around.

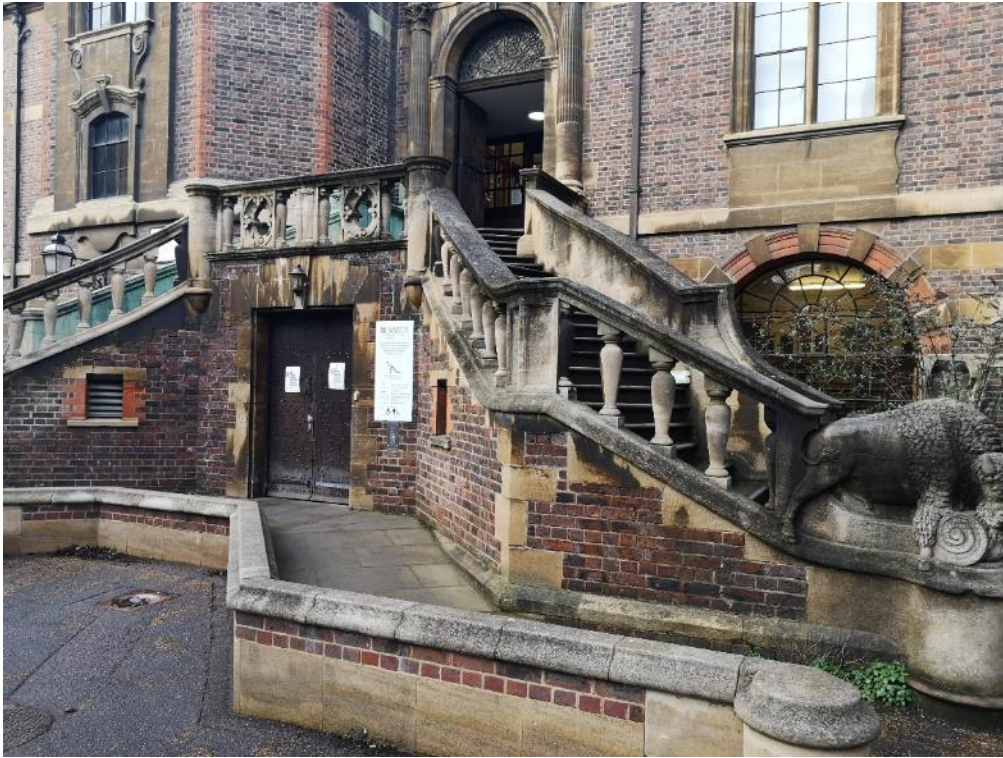
The Museum has steps going up to it
